Sevenoaks Academy School Uniform Policy

Students attending Sevenoaks Academy are required to wear a uniform. This consists of a Sevenoaks short or long sleeve shirt, zippered or non-zippered hoodie, track pants or shorts. We also have baseball caps available. All of these items can be purchased through the office. Please contact administrator@sevenoaksacademy.ca to place an order.

The only substitution permitted is for the track pants or shorts where students can wear **solid black** bottoms instead.

Please ensure that you label all items of clothing.

The last Friday of each month the students are invited to wear thematic clothing that is designated by the school, such as;

September – Orange, Truth & Reconciliation Day

October – Halloween costume

November – White, to celebrate the snowy season to come

December – Red & Green for the holidays

January – Pyjama's

February – Pink, anti-bullying

March – Free dress choice

April – Free dress choice

May – Wear a colour to represent cancer research, National Cancer Research Month

June – Pride, wear the colours of the rainbow

If the student does not wish to participate in the month's theme, then they are expected to wear the school uniform.

All articles of clothing are expected to be in good condition. Please take the time to inspect your child's clothing for rips, tears, or holes and repair them. Students who come to school with clothing in disrepair will be given a second-hand shirt to wear for the day.
